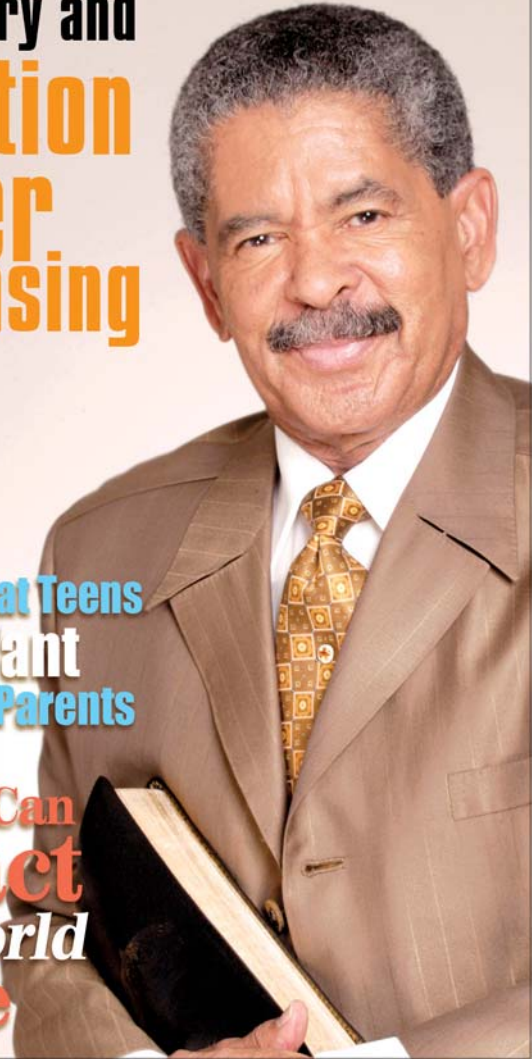

# The History of Ever Increasing Faith

**A**fter being on radio several times a week for a number of years, in April 1978, Ever Increasing Faith, the missionary outreach arm of Crenshaw Christian Center, began televising the faith message locally.

Later, following the directive of the Holy Spirit, Apostle Price expanded the television ministry to five major U.S. cities in an effort to reach Black America: Chicago, IL.; Detroit, MI; New York City, NY; Washington, D.C.; and Los Angeles, CA. Just as Paul, an apostle to the Gentiles, never lost sight of his Jewish brethren, Apostle Price desired to reach his Black brethren with the Word of Faith and prosperity that is in Christ Jesus. He has endeavored to do so through television, radio, cable, satellite and the internet.

The Sunday Morning Worship Services, taught in the church sanctuary formerly located at Crenshaw Boulevard and Hardy Avenue in

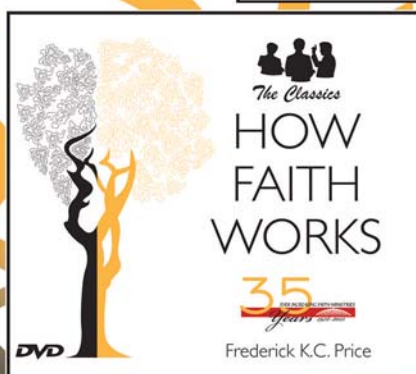
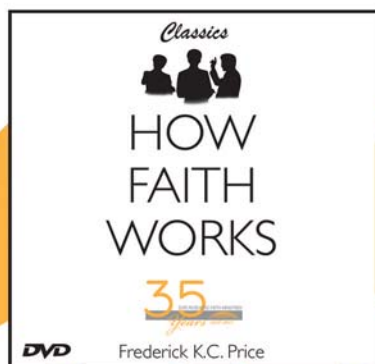
Inglewood, CA, served as the studio for the taping of the television broadcast. The local congregation was his audience. This undertaking necessitated the help of skilled and faithful volunteers and professionals who would commit to assisting with bringing the Word of Faith to the television and radio audience. Eventually, as the church again needed larger facilities, in 1981, Crenshaw Christian Center purchased the 32-acre former campus of Pepperdine University in Los Angeles, CA, primarily for the construction of a 10,000-seat sanctuary. Groundbreaking for the new sanctuary took place in 1986 and the building was completed in the fall of 1989.

The sanctuary, the FaithDome, is a geodesic dome (one of the largest in the world) used for Sunday services, special meetings, conventions and crusades. Consequently, the FaithDome now serves as the studio for taping of the television ministry. In 2003, Ever Increasing Faith began broadcasting its Sunday Worship services live via the internet and in December 2003, the

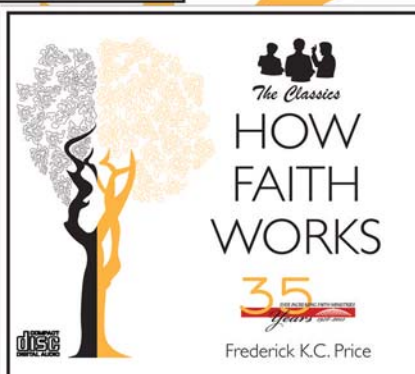

As a result of the television outreach, Apostle Price held numerous television crusades in the five major cities and expanded these meetings to other venues such as Miami, FL; Atlanta, GA; and Newark, New Jersey. He also made numerous mission trips to Africa, to places such as Nigeria, Ghana, Namibia and South Africa. Just as the Apostle Paul established several churches as a result of his missions outreach, due to the outreach of Ever Increasing Faith, Apostle Price established Crenshaw Christian Center New York in 2001 and Crenshaw Christian Center Namibia in 2008.

In an effort to continuously connect to our television audience, Ever Increasing Faith established two other outreach ministries. The Ever Increasing Faith Messenger magazine began circulation in 1980 and was renamed the Ever Increasing Faith Magazine in 2006. The magazine is now available both in print and online as a download from the ministry's website. The EIF E-Newsletter was established in 2009. Ministry at Sea Cruises and Tours was established in 1985, allowing our television audience to receive ministry of the Word in a relaxed

setting and to encourage their family and friends to do likewise - particularly those who otherwise would never set foot in a church.

Today, Ever Increasing Faith is carried on 129 stations in the United States and 4 foreign stations. It is also carried on several international satellite networks. The broadcast reaches over 42 million TV households in the US. — EIF

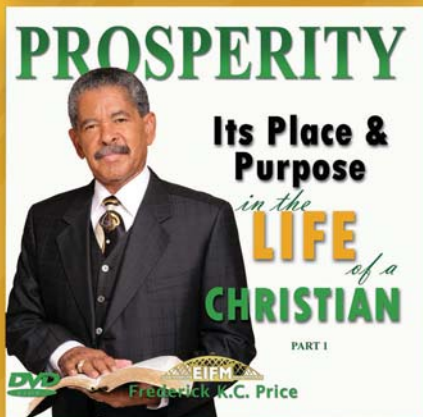
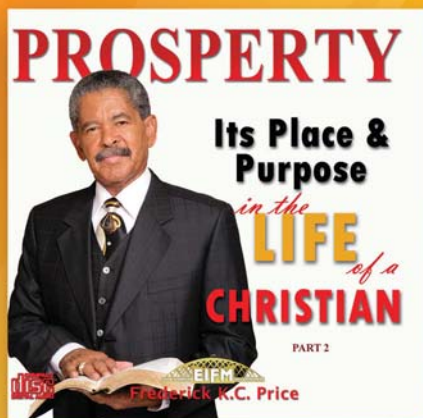

# A Healthy Mind: The Doorway To A Healthy Body

When a person receives and confesses Jesus Christ as their personal Savior and Lord, his spirit is born again. This is an immediate transaction. From that point, the believer must begin the process of a daily diet of the Word of God to renew the mind. When we become born again, it is the spirit of man that is regenerated. The soul (mind, will, intellect and emotions) and body are not.

In order to be a doer of the Word of God, we must renew the mind. We have to get rid of stinkin' thinkin' because wrong thinking can lead to the destruction of your own body. Each individual has a responsibility to the Lord to take care of his or her body. You are the caretaker. What are you doing? What are you putting in it? Where are you taking it? What are you doing with it?

The believer's mind must become renewed

to doing things God's way—it is a process. Man is a free-moral agent and has the ability to choose and with that choice, not even the Lord will change a person's will or actions. God will not violate man's will. However, you will never understand the Bible with natural thinking because it is spiritual. That is why every believer should be filled with the Holy Spirit, with the evidence of speaking in other tongues (Acts 2:4). The Holy Spirit is our Helper who will assist us through the process in our personal walk with God.

Now the flesh (evil human desires, sinful deeds) is still present and if allowed by the choice of our own will is capable of manifesting any and everything we practiced before the new birth. The flesh wants to dominate and keep us enslaved to sin. However, a renewed mind will

allow the fruit of the spirit to overcome the flesh. Whatever we feed will grow. If we feed our spirit man in the Word, in prayer, fellowship with God and have a conscience that is sensitive to the Holy Spirit's prompting, then our spirit is strong and able to occupy, saturate our soul. Only a strengthened spirit is able to overcome the flesh. If we starve our spirit, it means that we are feeding our flesh more and then the flesh will dominate. It is important to practice setting our minds on the spirit where the Lord dwells.

These are the results of not renewing the mind:

- Deadly emotions
- Unhealthy stress
- Physical and/or mental illness
- Imaginations that do not agree with the Word
- Suicide
- Anxiety
- Toxic thoughts and attitude

A high percentage of individuals seem to approach their lives like a roller-coaster ride at an amusement park. They allow their lives to happen to them. They strap themselves in with grim determination, hanging on during the ups, downs, excitement and fear. They don't even realize how much stress they are internalizing. Not all stress is bad stress. However, the longer the ride lasts, the more accustomed they become to the knots in their stomach and the tension in their necks. This is man trying to cope with negative situations and circumstances of daily living.

The verdict of science is in – the mind-body connection is real. No longer can we re-

legate those so-called psychosomatic disorders to the dark corners of the mind. Behavior starts with a thought. Thoughts stimulate emotions, which then result in attitude and finally produce behavior. This symphony of electrochemical reactions in the body affects the way we think and feel physically. Therefore, toxic thoughts produce toxic emotions, which produce toxic attitudes resulting in toxic behavior.

Every believer has the responsibility to examine, evaluate and discern whether their thoughts are coming from Satan. This is why we must know the Word of God. The enemy attempts to cause us to think, 'oh that's just me thinking those thoughts, ideas and suggestions.' If your thoughts do not agree with God's Word, we are instructed to cast those imaginations down. Thoughts, ideas and suggestions come to get you off focus of the Word of God.

Remember – we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities; chief magistrates over cities, states, nations.

They are top generals who give orders to destroy God's plans; they are controlling demonic spirits that bring a person under satanic influence. These demonic forces enter through the thought life by vain imaginations and seducing spirits who try to draw us away from the truth of God's Word. They exalt themselves, lie and try to influence our thought life.

The good news is that these toxic thoughts, emotions and attitudes are controllable, and that means your physical and emotional well-being is controllable too. Begin now to become a doer of God's Word and not a hearer only because only the doer is blessed in what he does.—EIF

# The Fragrance

**A**t the writing of this article, I am making preparations to go on a trip to Mulheim, Germany. The purpose of this overseas outreach is to minister and teach worship and praise to German churches that are hungry for God's presence. As a worshiper and student of the Word of Faith, I am ever aware of the power of faith to change lives; the same power that changed my life many years ago. And as I prepare for this trip, I recognize the effect that being in God's presence has on our lives. As Christian believers, when we enter His gates with thanksgiving in our hearts and His courts with praise (Psalm 100:4), we immediately become aware that we leave God's presence differently than we came. We leave with a residue that I call: the fragrance of faith.

Coming from a large family and being the youngest child of 10 children (5 boys and 5 girls), I knew what it was like to have to share my parents. As a young, energetic boy I would often fall and otherwise injure myself and seek to be consoled by my parents (much like we run to our Heavenly Father for refuge and comfort.). So when I did get hurt, off I went to seek my father or my mother to kiss my "boo-boo" and make it all better. Only thing was, to a little kid in a big, two-story row house in Baltimore, Maryland, finding which room my mother or father was in often was quite a daunting task. But I figured out a way to find them, no matter what room they were in—follow their fragrance.

I might be dating myself but my parents wore old-school fragrances. My mom wore a perfume called Tabu and my dad wore a cologne called Royal Copenhagen. Judging by the fragrance, I could always tell where they had been. I would continue to use my "aromatic GPS" to

locate one of them and fall into their arms.

As most kids do, I relished in the fact that I had my mom or dad's full attention and their embrace. And as a result of the hug I received, some of their scent would get on me and linger throughout the day. So much so that when my other siblings would come around me, they would say, "Hey, you were just with Mama!"

This is the same set of circumstances we find ourselves in when we come into God's presence with singing (Psalm 100:2). As we draw nigh to God, not only do we find safety and refuge, but we are to draw so close to him that His fragrance gets on us. (His heart love, purpose, plans, pursuits, anointing and His glory.

Take just a moment and ask yourself: "Am I a carrier of God's fragrance? Is there residue on my life that is reminiscent of my time spent in the Throne Room?" As God's children, we should change the very atmosphere of the stores and businesses in the marketplace that we frequent. People should often say of us, "There's something about you... Something that brings me peace, as well as a sense of conviction." This is not because of our own righteousness, but because of His grace and because of our abiding time in His presence.

Now at the onset of this article, I mentioned the upcoming trip to Mulheim Germany that the Lord has called me to embark on in a few days. I am truly excited (and honored) that the

Lord would entrust me to represent His Kingdom as I teach and minister on worship, internationally. I will in fact be a "fragrant carrier" as I go. You see, as a student of the word of faith, specifically a student of my Apostle, Dr. Frederick K.C. Price, I have the responsibility to infuse the environment with faith and power. As I am sent, it is my prayer that the fragrance of faith emanates and fills the air with a bouquet of "We walk by faith, not by sight" and with a sweet smelling savor of "So then faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the Word of God."

Many often speak of the alabaster box of expensive perfume that was brought to Jesus by the woman in Matthew 26:7. I've asked myself the question: "Exactly what kind of fragrant oil was in that box?" Thru' God's own Son.

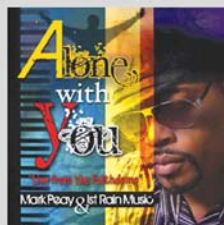

But I know a seed that was planted in me by God. I needed the best and a powerful healing. I started reading my Bible and listening and becoming a student of the Word. I would sit on the edge of my seat when Apostle would speak because I knew it was a treat to receive the wisdom and anointed Word through him. My life now has a lot of promise and I am thankful everyday to be alive. My outlook is now from a Christ-like perspective and I constantly stay in prayer. # Getting the Skinny on Belly Fat

**A**bdominal obesity became the focus of researchers in the 1980s when they realized that it had an important connection to cardiovascular disease, diabetes, and metabolic disease which could potentially be linked to Alzheimer's disease. It can occur in both children and teenagers if either of their parents have abdominal obesity. Scientists have come to recognize that body fat, instead of body weight, is the key to evaluating obesity.

The common causes of having belly fat in adults include menopause, genetics, improper digestion, stress, poor posture and slow metabolism. Stress, overeating, ingesting fattening food items and a lack of physical exercise can all cause fat to accumulate around your midsection. Obesity plays an important role in the impairment of lipid and carbohydrate metabolism shown in high-carbohydrate diets. The prevalence of abdominal obesity is increasing in western populations, due to a combination of low physical activity and high-fat diets.

Study after study proves that eating a well-balanced diet heavy with fruits, veggies, whole grains and low fat items, plus exercising regularly, will help you shed not only subcutaneous



fat (the surface fat that makes love handles), but also the deeper visceral fat, which builds up around abdominal organs and can raise your chance of suffering high cholesterol, heart disease, or type 2 diabetes. Scientists are studying the link between stress and belly fat.

What is the solution for the obesity epidemic in the church?

Nearly one-half of the American population will be obese by 2030 according to a 2012 study published in the American Journal of Preventative Medicine. The researchers estimate that this will result in an additional \$66 billion in health care expenditures, 7.8 million new cases of diabetes, 6.8 million new cases of stroke and heart disease, and more than 500,000 new cancer diagnoses. This epidemic of obesity and commonly associated diseases creates a gash in the fabric of our country that threatens the future of individuals, families, and our nation.

But a potentially larger crisis is looming in the churches across America. In fact, statistics suggest that the church today may indeed be in worse condition than the general population. A 2008 Purdue study found that the fundamental Christians are by far the heaviest of all religious groups led by the Baptists with 30% obesity rate compared with Jews at 1%, Buddhists and Hindus at 0.7%

Researchers state that America is becoming a nation of gluttony and obesity, and the churches are a feeding ground for this problem. A recent study of 2,500 clergy found that 75% were overweight or obese compared to 61% of the general population at the time of the study. At the church level pastors and clergy are burdened by the skyrocketing number of their members with chronic diseases such as cancer and heart disease.

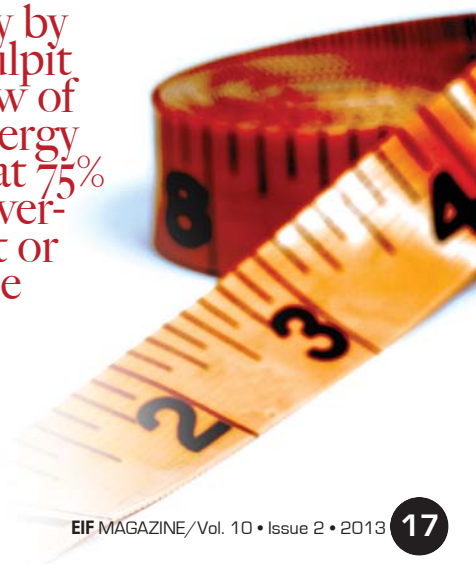

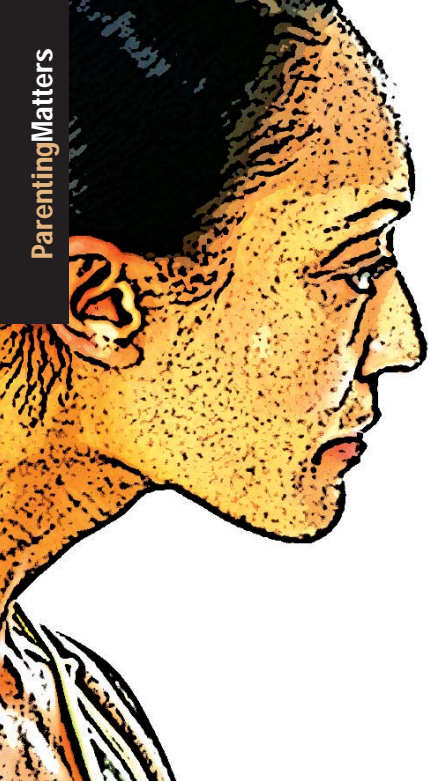
even rarer on the vice of gluttony; it has become a secret and acceptable vice in the modern church. The obesity epidemic in the church appears to be undermining the primary purpose of the church and its mission work by straining church budgets, decidedly absorbing money that would be spent on other programs.

I must admit our Apostle Dr. Frederick K. C. Price has always spoken to his congregation about the perils of being overweight and he has taken a considerable amount of persecution for this, but he was only attempting to convey to us the dangers of carrying excess weight.

A permanent routine of exercise, eating healthier, and consuming the same number or lower calories than used will prevent and help fight obesity. —EIF

Some time ago, we ministered at a family retreat. One of the questions presented to the teens that attended the retreat was, "What do you want most from your parents?" The number one thing they said they wanted was time with their parents; number two was to know that they were one of the most important things in their parent's life, and finally, they wanted their parents to protect them. All of these teens were Christians, from Christian homes and all attended private Christian schools. Incredible isn't it? Most, if not all, were taller and physically stronger than their parents were yet one of their primary needs was that their parents protect them. Now, these young people were not from the inner city – most lived in very affluent neighborhoods.

After talking at length, we found out that the protection they were referring to was not from vandals or gang members. They wanted to be protected from social pressures by having established family values, curfews, house rules, and dress standards—boundaries that give them a way of escape from the world's standards. Teens don't want their parents to control their lives but to give

guidelines to follow. Many parents in an attempt to be accepted by their children or to become friends with their children

set no standards or no boundaries for them to follow, leaving their children to their own devices.

I know of a family who had five teenagers. One day, their mother sat them down and told them she had read reports that indicated that teen smoking was at an all time high. The mother continued telling her children of a tragic incident that occurred when a teen bought a pack of cigarettes, smoked the cigarettes and died because the cigarettes had been laced with a deadly drug. In an attempt to keep the same tragedy from happening to her children, she announced that if they wanted to smoke they could smoke at home and she would buy the cigarettes for them to ensure their safety. The teens (who had friends who smoked) were shocked when they heard their mother's

announcement. They'd never considered smoking because they knew that their mother would "kill" them if they did. This fear (referential) was the protection their mother had provided that kept them from smoking - not the community anti-drug program.

Something happened to those children that day. Their mother took away their protection. The next day when offered a cigarette at school they said, "No, thank you. We will smoke at home." That afternoon all five of the teens came home and smoked a cigarette. Why, because their mother had removed their safety net or in other words, she lowered the standard. Their mother continued to do the same thing with drugs and

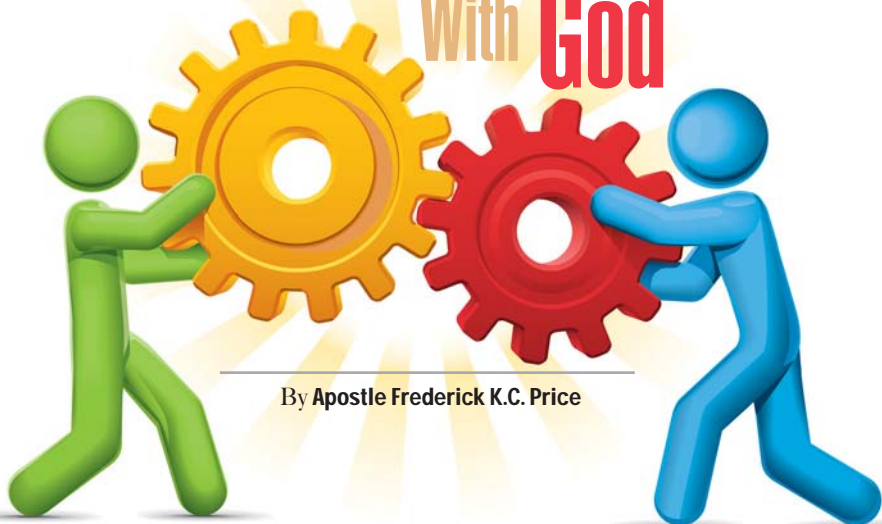
sex. Many years later, three of the five children are alcoholics. All of her children were promiscuous.

How could such a tragedy

happen? Simply because one by one the house rules, curfews, boundaries and moral standards were eliminated. They lost their protection, their moral compass - they had no path to follow. They were left to their own ways. How tragic. Giving young people their space and letting them make decisions has its place. However, when we as parents completely remove boundaries and eliminate standards for our children to live by, it's like removing the lane markings on a highway with no speed limit - disaster is inevitable. If your teens challenge the boundaries you have set, be courageous and let them know what your family represents.

Will they jump up and down and worship you? No! Probably not right away. But someday when your son is hired for a job because he is the only applicant with good character references or when your daughter is asked to work as a camp counselor because she is seen as a role model to younger girls, they will appreciate the boundaries that were set. One day, Proverbs 31:28 "Her children arise and called her blessed" will be your testimony. Don't be afraid to give your children what they need, a courageous parent!—EIF

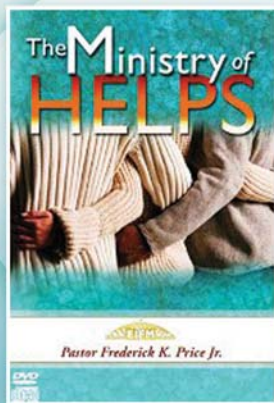

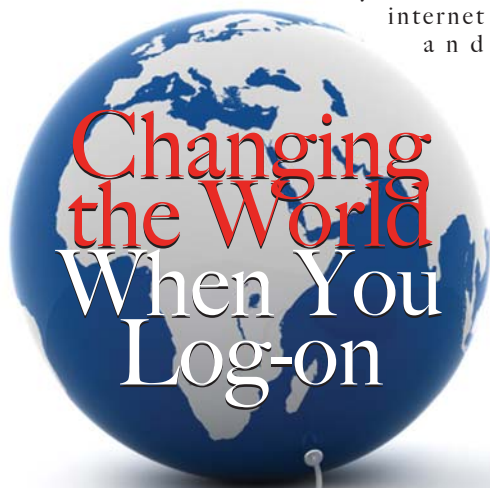

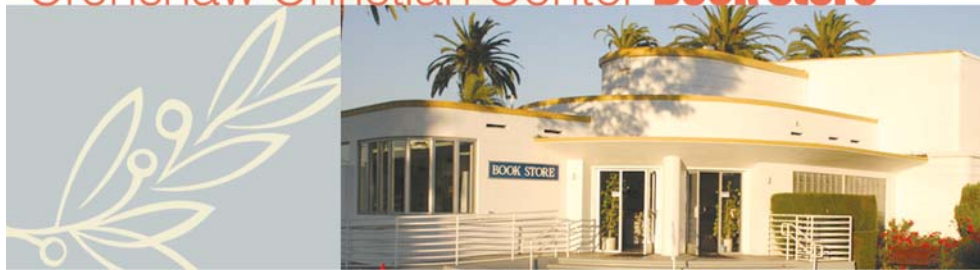

## APOSTLE AND DR. BETTY PRICE



### With so many successful years in ministry, what advice do you have for young pastors?

That question is one that I have been asked over and over again for many years. What I've found out is that most ministers don't have a clue about their assignment. They sense a call to the

ministry but they don't take the time to find out what their assignment is. It's one thing to be called, but another thing to be called to do something specific which is my assignment. I always ask people, "do you know what God has called you to do?" Because technically every Christian is a preacher, which is a verbal proclaimer but that's not necessarily a minister. So what's my ministry gift? I always challenge them to find that out. Then apply the principles in the teaching *How Faith Works*. The law of faith is the foundation of everything. I consider success fulfilling my assignment. In the country, wagons would go down the roads so often it would put a rut in the dirt. Every time the wagon went down the road, it would fall into a rut. I've wanted to do other things, but I always fall back into my rut. That's what I share with other ministers.
